MINUTES OF PRE-BID MEETING
(DATED 28-10-2025)

Reference to the approved minutes of meeting vide NITB's letter number NITB-4(424)/2025 dated 4th November, 2025.

Discussion / Decisions

1. In response to Tender Notice, representatives of seventeen (17) prospective bidders attended the pre-bid meeting. The chair opened the forum for discussion in which different queries with regard to bid document were raised. The discussion and decisions are as follows:

Sr.#	Query	Clarification
1	JV is requested to be allowed for this project.	A Joint Venture with a maximum of two partners will be allowed. The bidders will provide the undertaking for the success of the project from both of the partners having a joint venture. Both partners have to provide their capabilities in terms of the Smart City project deployments.
2.	Bidders requested for the Bid submission date extension	The bid submission deadline is extended till 18th November, 2025. The proposal will be opened on the same day.
3	Who will facilitate the provision of the required data to all bidders and Should the proposed solution align with the use cases and sub-use cases defined in the RFP?	NITB will facilitate the provision of the requisite data, whereas each bidder will be responsible for presenting a comprehensive technical solution according to the use cases and sub use cases defined in the RFP.
4	Are bidders required to submit a comprehensive proposal for all Digital Twin and Fusion Center components?	Each bidder shall submit a comprehensive proposal covering all components relevant to the Digital Twin and Fusion Center. All bidders will be required to present their proposed solutions following the submission of bids. The date & time will be communicated, afterwards.
5	What should a bidder provide as part of their submission, including solution components, platforms, and BOQs?	Each bidder must provide the major/minor solution components including different platforms i.e. GIS, 3D Maps along with data, Cloud and connection



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		resources and any other platform mandatory for the Smart City etc. along with the BoQs, to facilitate the finalization of the RFP. The bidders must also propose the design of Command and Control Center.
6	What should a proposed solution include in terms of a data security framework	The proposed solution must include a robust data security framework and a complete plan for the establishment of the Command and Control Center (CCC), along with other components forming part of the Digital Twin initiative. The prospective venue for the Command and Control Center will be shared after finalization from relevant authorities.
