TECHNICAL EVALUATION REPORT FOR THE TENDER “INDEPENDENT VALIDATION AND AUDIT OF ONLINE PORTAL & COMPLETE PROCESS/PROCEDURE FOR THE AGRICULTURAL TRAINING OF 1,000 PROFESSIONALS IN CHINA” (TENDER NO. NITB-4(415)/2025

2. The agenda of the meetings was to evaluate the bids against Eligibility Criteria, and Technical Evaluation Criteria of the RFP.

Discussion / Decisions

3. The Committee evaluated the bids as per the following:

a) Stage I- Eligibility Criteria:

The Committee evaluated all three (03) bids received from the bidders named Awami System Technologies (Pvt.) Ltd., M/s CyberVision International, and Cybercom (Pvt.) Ltd. against the ‘Eligibility Criteria’ of the RFP.

M/s Cybervision International was declared unqualified due to non-compliance of requirement vide serial no. 1 of section 9.1: ‘Eligibility Criteria’ i.e. “*Bidder is an entity duly registered and incorporated as a company minimum for last 03 years under the laws of Pakistan*”. The required information / document was found missing in their bid.

b) Stage II- Technical Evaluation:

Awami System Technologies (Pvt.) Ltd., and Cybercom (Pvt.) Ltd. were evaluated against the section 9.2: ‘Technical Evaluation Criteria’ of the RFP. The summary of marks obtained by these two bidders is as below: (Evaluation Sheet is attached as Annex-1)

1.	Awami System Technologies (Pvt.) Ltd.	80
2.	Cybercom (Pvt.) Ltd.	53

4. As per the RFP, minimum 70 marks was required for the Technical Qualification hence the Cybercom (Pvt.) Ltd. is hereby declared Technically Disqualified.
5. The Committee recommends proceeding with the opening of the financial bid of the Technically Qualified bidder expeditiously. As a sole bidder has qualified technically, the financial conformance in terms of rate reasonability must be undertaken as per Rule 38B(d) of PPRA Rules, 2004.
